
MATLAB License Agreement

This software is provided to you under an agreement between The Ohio State University and The MathWorks, Inc. Under the terms of the license agreement, current faculty, academic staff and students may use this software while they are associated with the University. Faculty, academic staff and students are licensed for a standard configuration. See the web site below to see a description the configuration. When you are no longer a current faculty, staff or student, you must return this software to your department or the Office of Information Technology (OIT). **This license is renewed annually. The license codes expire each September. Renewal fees, if any, will be determined each renewal year.** These will be announced and will be posted on http://oit.osu.edu/site_license under the MATLAB software listing.

The software may be used only for classroom instruction and academic research activities (University business). Commercial use is prohibited. Licenses cannot be provided to individuals of University research and development divisions or centers of OSU. No user may alter, adapt, translate, reverse engineer or convert the Programs with the intent of performing the same or similar function or to gain access to the source code. This software may not be used outside the USA. Programs mean the MATLAB software, enhancements, corrections and documentation licensed by OSU from The MathWorks. You may run multiple simultaneous Program sessions on not more than two separate processors, whether located in the same or different computers.

Faculty and academic staff may install the software on computers owned or operated by The Ohio State University on main and regional campuses. In addition license holders may use this on their home computer or laptop for University business only.

Faculty and academic staff are allowed to install this software on one campus and home computer unless specifically authorized by your department as a computer support representative to install multiple copies. You agree to the use terms of this agreement, and if you are authorized to install multiple copies, you must advise anyone who is using or receiving any of those copies that they are prohibited from distributing, modifying or making copies of the software, and you must supply them with this agreement. You agree to assure that their signed End User Agreement is returned to OIT in 512 Baker Systems.

This software may be used by students in University computer labs and on one personal computer. Student use is limited to meeting classroom requirements and courses of study offered by the University. Students may not copy or distribute the Programs to other persons.

This software is protected by both United States copyright laws and international treaty provisions. Each installed copy of the program is registered with the Office of Information Technology as a function of your agreeing with these terms. Archival copies of this software may be made for the sole purpose of backing up your software.
